Attendees of this program will need to have completed the **Pass Issuing Operator Standard program**.

### Security Controllers

The Security Staff program is designed for users that interact with the alarms and transactions inside the AC2000 environment. Example topics covered: Security Hub and One Shot. The Security Controller program is split into two online programs, **standard** and **administrator**.

#### Security Controller Operator Standard

The Security Controllers program is designed to cover basic topics relating to the operation and monitoring of the AC2000 access control system's alarms and events. It focuses on the needs of the Security Control room Staff and all attendees will gain the required knowledge for dealing with alarms and monitoring activity.

#### Security Controller Operator Administrator

This program is designed for the Senior/Administrative security control staff that need to configure control room user accounts including setting permissions, assigning alarms to different team members, creating workflows, and configuring maps. Attendees of this program will need to have completed the **Security Controller Standard program**.
